Written Examinations

During this reporting period, 612 CDT written examinations were administered. Figure 1 shows a breakdown of the total number of written examinations administered. The largest portion of written examinations administered were for Comprehensive (34%), followed by Recognized Graduate (20%), Crown & Bridge (14%), Complete Dentures (13%), Ceramics (12%), Implants (3%), Orthodontics (2%), and Partial Dentures (2%).





Figure 2 shows the overall Pass and Fail results for all written examinations with more than 15 examinees.












